The choice of yarn for your booties is crucial in determining their softness, durability, and overall aesthetic appeal. For this project, worsted weight yarn is highly recommended due to its versatility and availability in a wide range of colors and textures. Consider using a soft and machine-washable yarn for easy care and everyday wearability.

1. **Cast on:** Using your size 5 knitting needles, cast on 32 stitches.
2. **Knit 1, Purl 1 Ribbing:** Knit one stitch, then purl one stitch. Repeat this pattern for the entire row.
3. **Repeat Row 2:** Knit another row of ribbing.

1. **Mark the Center:** Insert a stitch marker between the 16th and 17th stitches. This will mark the center of your heel.
  2. **Slip Stitches:** Knit the first 16 stitches onto a spare needle, hold them in the back. Slip the next two stitches onto a stitch holder.
  3. **Knit Central Stitches:** Knit the next 12 stitches (24 stitches total).
1. **Slip Stitches Back:** Slip the two stitches from the stitch holder back onto the left-hand needle, then knit the 16 stitches from the spare needle back onto the left-hand needle.
  2. **Knit to Center Marker:** Knit even until you reach the stitch marker.
  3. **Turn:** Turn the work and slip the first stitch purlwise.
1. **Purl Row:** Purl across all stitches.
  2. **Knit Row:** Knit across all stitches.
  3. **Repeat Rows 1 and 2:** Repeat these two rows until the heel flap measures approximately 2 inches.
1. **Increase Stitches:** On the next knit row, knit into the front and back of the first stitch (2 stitches increased).
  2. **Knit Row:** Knit even.
  3. **Decrease Stitches:** Repeat Row 1 at the end of the next purl row.
1. **Join the Stitches:** Knit the stitches from the heel flap (26 stitches) together with the stitches from the instep (28 stitches).

2. **Knit Even:** Knit all stitches until the foot measures approximately 3 inches.
  
1. **Toe Decreases:** On the next knit row, knit two together and knit to the end of the round (2 stitches decreased).
2. **Decrease Rows:** Repeat Row 1 every other round until there are 10 stitches remaining.
3. **Thread and Close:** Thread the yarn through the remaining stitches and pull it tight to close the toe.
  
1. **Weave in Ends:** Use a yarn needle to weave in the loose ends.
2. **Blocking:** Place the booties on a flat surface and block them to shape.
