3. Place the remaining stitches on a holder or a spare needle.
4. Knit back and forth on the first half of the stitches, decreasing one stitch at the beginning and end of every row until there are 12 stitches left.

5. Knit the two halves of the heel together (24 stitches).

### **Completing the Cuff:**

1. Pick up 12 stitches around the heel.
2. Knit the picked-up stitches together with the stitches on the needles (48 stitches).
3. Knit 10 rounds.
4. Bind off all stitches.

### **Adding the Finishing Touches:**

1. Sew the side seams of the booties.
2. Weave in any loose ends.
3. Optional: Embellish the booties with pom-poms, ribbons, or buttons.

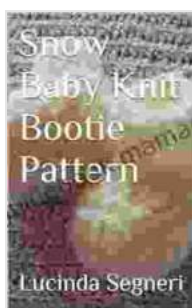
### **Tips for Knitting Perfect Snow Baby Booties**
